In the process they acquire skills necessary to build a well-rounded personality. We are fortunate to have a team of committed and passionate teachers who nurture our students on this path.

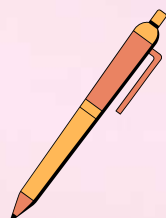

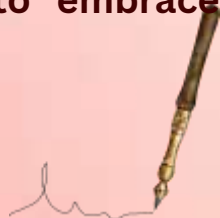

Chakshu house conducted a plethora of activities to awaken a spirit of self reliance and responsibility in the students.

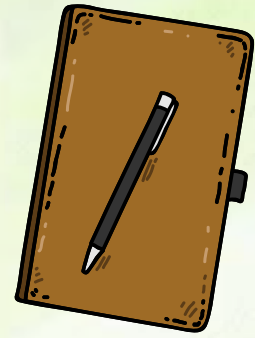
